The Drexel University Alumni Association Wins Gold CASE Circle of Excellence Award

The Drexel University Alumni Association is pleased to announce that it won a Gold Award in the Council for Advancement and Support of Education (CASE) 2010 Circle of Excellence Competition for its outreach program, the Community Alumni Network at Drexel University (CAN DU). Among thirty-four other entries in the Collaborative Programs category, CAN DU was one of just two Gold Award recipients.

The Collaborative Programs category recognizes collaborative partnerships which demonstrate creativity and innovation in thought and execution, show solid results, and support the mission of the institution. CAN DU sponsors two major community service programs a year, bringing together both alumni and student volunteers, as well as collaborating with more than twenty campus and community partners. 
Alumni Weekend Reunion Committees: Class of 1961 and 1986


