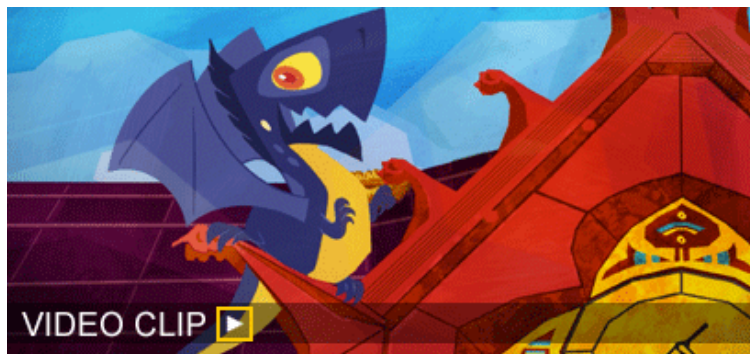

Anuja Kapri, Finance '15, Design & Merchandising '15: After Earthquake, Nepali Drexel Students, Grad Rallying for Their Country

As an international student from Pakistan, Azfer Saeed needed to find an employer who would sponsor his work visa after graduation. It would take over a year, and a great deal of hard work, but Saeed finally got his visa sponsorship in late 2007 and was working.

There was just one problem. He found himself in an IT role that was, for him, boring and unfulfilling. "At that point, I had to figure out what I really wanted to do with my life," he says. "And life has a funny way of working out. There was something better in store for me that I didn't realize at the time."

Saeed eventually took a new job as a product specialist for a company called GlobalSubmit, where he marketed and sold pharmaceutical software to the life sciences industry and government agencies. While there, Saeed was part of a website redesign project which ignited in him an interest in analytics and digital marketing. >>

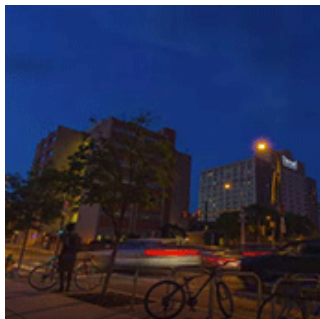
