



A Drexel delegation including Drexel President John Fry; Stan Silverman '69, '74, trustee; Julie Mostov, vice president of Global Initiatives; deans of the Graduate College, the Close School of Entrepreneurship, the Antoinette Westphal College of Media & Arts and Design; and faculty and senior administrative staff recently returned from a successful trip to Shanghai, China and Seoul, South Korea.



Less than four hours after landing in Shanghai, the Drexel delegation met with our community of alumni, parents, friends and current co-op and study abroad students. The attendees were excited for the opportunity to meet with President Fry and the delegation, as well as fellow Drexel dragons. Current students in particular appreciated meeting and speaking with the local crowd, and made significant connections that will further enrich their time in Shanghai. The next two

days in Shanghai were spent with our partners at ShanghaiTech and Shanghai Jiao Tung University. **Click here** for an article that Silverman wrote after hearing President Fry speak at both universities.

The group arrived in Seoul on November 4, for the opening ceremony for the Drexel NNFC FIRST Nano Co-op — a collaboration between Drexel University and Korea Advanced Institute of Science and Technology (KAIST). The schedule for Seoul included a visit to Seoul National University and an alumni reception, where again the energy in the room was great!
