Recent Serious Illness or Injury to Student	<ol> <li>A detailed explanation of the medical circumstances, including the date of occurrence, duration, and how it negatively affected your academic success.</li> <li>Supporting documentation (e.g., physician's statement, copy of police report).</li> <li>Supporting documentation regarding what steps you've taken to improve your ability to complete your coursework successfully (e.g., physician's statement or third-party agency that assisted you during your illness or injury).</li> </ol>
